Day of Test entries are **\$25.00** for each entry, and will close 30 minutes prior to roll call at the Field Trial Secretary's table. **Day of Test entries accepted as space allows. A stand-by list will be created and these dogs will be allowed to run if time permits.** Closing date is May 22, 2019. If the trial has not filled, day of show entries will be accepted until 8:00. **Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be accepted.** Entries are accepted online at **sugarloafmountainracing.com** or by mail. Online entries are instantly confirmed and will have an additional \$0.50 processing fee added per entry. Entries will be acknowledged by email if legible email address is provided in entry form.

Conditions of Entry

Dogs must have an AKC registration number and be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Dogs may only run once per test. One dog per entry form. All entries must be accompanied with a check or online payment to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

At roll call, all dogs will be examined for disqualifications. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the test. At inspection, bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded.

What is the Fast CAT?

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. At roll call, all dogs will be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps. Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)}$

Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied, and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS}$

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Building Hours

Crown Sports Center is air conditioned/climate controlled. The building is available from 12:00pm until 7:00pm on Wednesday evening for setup. Doors will open at 6:30am each day.

Trial Hours

9:00am until all runs are completed. TKC/SMKC will do its best to accommodate exhibitors with conflicts in agility. However, exhibitors must notify the Field Trial Secretary of possible conflicts and must work their dog into the running order during the regular test schedule. No dogs will be moved up, if you are not available when called your dog will be skipped but not marked absent, the next dog will be called. You may enter your dog in the running order at any time after the dog has been skipped during the test.

Prizes

TKC/SMKC will offer a light blue flat ribbon for a passing qualifying run.

TKC/SMKC will offer placement rosettes at each trial for:

- Fastest 1st-4th in under 12" class
- Fastest 1st-4th in 12" to 18" class
- Fastest 1st-4th in 18" or greater class

TKC/SMKC will have a limited number of title rosettes available. Please notify the trial secretary, via email or include with your entry form, if you will be earning the following titles to ensure that the club will have rosettes available.

US-13 north and follow Business US-13 north, then turn right on Crown Road.

Trial Information

- Crating space indoors is limited. Please be conservative. X-Pens allowed for multiple dog crating only.
- WATERPROOF MATS REQUIRED UNDER ALL CRATES that are indoors.
- NO CLEATS ALLOWED indoors. Running shoes and turf shoes acceptable.
- Please pick up after your dogs so we can continue to use this wonderful facility. Any exhibitor caught not cleaning up after their dog will be asked to leave the trial grounds. No refund will be given if this occurs. **A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing.**
- Parking in the rear of the building is advised for easy access to crating area.
- Dogs will not be permitted in certain areas of the building. These areas will be clearly marked.
- NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS allowed indoors. A cafeteria is available on the premises with a nice selection of food and drinks at reasonable prices.
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- **ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK**
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- An electronic timing system will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced. See photo for example of sheep fencing used for the course.
- On site indoor bathrooms are available.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running. Flexi-Leads **MUST** be kept at the 2' LOCKED position when used IN and NEAR the building.
- You are responsible for controlling your dogs and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry. You may use one form to enter one dog for all events. Use the checkbox and mark off each event you wish to enter, \$20.00 per entry.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. **Entry fees will be refunded.**
- The huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.

- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/TKC/SMKC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded.**

• **No entry fees will be refunded** if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the event-hosting clubs.
