Entry Fee

\$20.00 per entry per dog per test (Includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

Paper mail entries will NOT be accepted due to COVID-19. Closing date is March 17, 2021. No day of show entries will be permitted. Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be accepted. Entries are accepted only online at https://www.sugarloafmountainracing.com and no other methods of entry will be permitted due to COVID-19. Online entries will have an additional \$0.50 processing fee added per entry. Mailed entries with checks will be rejected and destroyed.

Conditions of Entry

Entries will be limited to 80 dogs per event, two events daily running concurrently 9:00AM-2:00PM. All owners must sign a coronavirus waiver, all owners must wear a mask at all times unless in their own cars, and all owners must include a name in the signed entry form of a trusted friend or family member to release his/her dog. Failure to include a name also entered in these events to release your dog will void your entire entry. Due to club insurance requirements, a current rabies certificate is required. Please include this along with your entry form and COVID waiver! Clubs are restricted from handling dogs to mitigate COVID-19 disease transmission, the hunt master and catch pen worker will be standing well outside of the course. The club table will also be off limits to everyone unless the owner is picking up awards. You may leave all your dog's awards and pick them up on the last day you are entered. Run your dog with a small break between runs if entered twice, and promptly leave the property. Any deviation or refusal to cooperate with the host club regarding wearing a mask will result in a bench hearing and immediate dismissal with no refunds.

Dogs must have an AKC registration number and be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Dogs may only run once per test. Entries received by phone, text, or email will not be accepted. Incomplete entries or forms without signature will not be accepted. Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

What is Fast CAT?

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

FORMULA: 204.545 / RUN TIME = MPH MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)

Based on the dog's size at the withers, a handicap is applied and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. Dogs will be examined for lameness before running. Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.

Trial Hours

Grounds will be available at 8:00 AM. There will be no on-site trial briefing due to COVID-19 restrictions. It is the responsibility of each entrant to make an effort to be ready when their dog is called to the line. Trial will begin promptly at 9:00AM until all runs are completed.

Prizes and Rosettes

Salisbury Maryland Kennel Club will offer a light blue flat ribbon for a passing qualifying run.

SMKC will offer placement rosettes at each trial for:

- Fastest 1st-4th in under 12" class
- Fastest 1st-4th in 12" to 18" class
- Fastest 1st-4th in 18" or greater class

Salisbury Maryland Kennel Club will have a limited number of title rosettes available. Please notify the show chair via email if you will be earning a new title to ensure that the club will have rosettes available. Due to COVID-19 related closures, there may be delays in obtaining additional title rosettes beyond what is on hand.

From South: US-13 North, US-50 West, turn left on Porter Mill Road (just past the Farmers Wife and Eatery), Right on to Deerfield Road.

From North: US-13 South, turn right onto Rd 28/Georgetown Rd Slight left onto Rd 28/Georgetown Rd/N Poplar St, turn right onto W Market St. Continue onto DE-24 W/West St, Keep left and continue Horsey Church. Keep right to continue Rd 509/St George Rd/Susan Beach Rd. Turn right onto DE-54 W, continue straight to stay on DE-54 W. Continue onto MD-54 W, turn left onto Old Railroad Rd. Turn right onto Porter Mill Rd, Turn right onto Deerfield Rd.

Trial Information

- Please pick up after your dog so we can continue to use this wonderful facility. Any exhibitor caught not cleaning up after their dog will be asked to leave the trial grounds. No refund will be given if this occurs. A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing.
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- An electronic timing system will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced. See photo for example of sheep fencing used for the course.
- On site portable bathrooms are available.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- You are responsible for controlling your dogs and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry. You may use one form to enter one dog for all events. Use the checkbox and mark off each event you wish to enter, \$20.00 per entry.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused.
- The huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/SMKC and any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded**.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the event-hosting clubs.
