Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after Closing

SMKC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing on Sept. 17, 2021. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Sun., Sept. 26, 2021 @ 6pm, will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Sun., Sept. 26, 2021 @ 6pm will receive a full refund.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Make Checks or Money Orders payable to "SMKC" only – no cash – and mailed to the trial secretary at the PO Box address ONLY. Worker certificates must be from the SMKC only trials.
- Be sure to include the correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size. Limit 10 entries per envelope.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, or fees, nor will telephone or FAX entries be accepted.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid. *****PLEASE WRITE EMAIL ADDRESS LEGIBLY!!!**
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$25 service fee will be added for all returned checks.
- Overnight service **MUST** be mailed through USPS and you **MUST** check **AND** sign the "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED" waiver box, as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries.
- SMKC DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information
- Entries not on Official AKC forms or on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current AKC agreement on the reverse side or attached to the entry form
- Entries which are illegible or incomplete, or entries received with insufficient fees
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, e-mail, telephone, FAX, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry
- A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

CONFIRMATIONS

- Confirmations will be sent via US mail ONLY if an exhibitor does not have an active e-mail address or upon specific request.
- A Preliminary Confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information in the confirmation for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections.

Contact us if you do not receive a preliminary confirmation before the closing date!

- Final confirmations of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC form after the closing date.

NOTE: If the exhibitor has not received the Final Confirmation within five days of the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

SMKC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. SMKC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the SMKC or any official thereof.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season and Dogs under 4 months of age will not be admitted to the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Qualifying flat ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH/PACH/PAX Rosettes and a decorated MACH/PACH/PAX bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH/PACH title at this trial. New title ribbons will be given to dogs earning a new title.

All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed.

MOVE UPS

Move ups must be sent in writing with the information below (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the Oct. 1st trial no later than Monday, Sept. 27th at 6pm. **Day to Day move ups (Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday) must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last run is judged for each class (STD, JWW, FAST).**

CLASSES OFFERED

Friday - All levels of STD, JWW, FAST, and Premier JWW.

Saturday - All levels of STD, JWW, FAST and Premier STD

Sunday - All levels of STD, JWW, plus Premier JWW & T2B

Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

RUNNING ORDER

Friday & Sunday HIGH to LOW (24C, 24, 20, 16, 12, 8, 4)
Saturday LOW to HIGH (4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 24C)

Classes will run in the following order:

Friday: All FAST (Ex/MAS, OPN, NOV), Ex/MAS STD, OPN STD, NOV STD, Premier JWW - Ex/MAS JWW, OPN JWW, NOV JWW

Saturday: Ex/MAS JWW, OPN JWW, NOV JWW, All FAST (Ex/MAS, OPN, NOV), PREM STD, Ex/MAS STD, OPN STD, NOV STD

Sunday: T2B, Ex/MAS STD, OPN STD, NOV STD, PREM JWW, Ex/MAS JWW, OPN JWW, NOV JWW

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

REGULAR	PREFERRED	INFORMATION
Exhibitors may chose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a lower height division than the AKC mandated height. NOTE: Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height division may optionally enter in 24-Choice (24C) jump height at their discretion.

😊 Simplified Jump Height Card Process 😊

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend –

Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form** must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

SMKC is offering FEO for all FAST & T2B classes.

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

REFUNDS

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the date of the trial.

Injury/Illness – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a partial refund minus \$6.50 for the 1st run and \$6 for each additional run (per day). A written vet letter (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Friday, October 1, 2021.

Validation of the injury/illness must be made by a licensed veterinarian. Requests from chiropractors, massage/physical therapists, etc will not be accepted.

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for AKC agility trials.

SMKC October 2021 Trial Instructions and Guidelines

Salisbury MD Kennel Club (SMKC) has put in place the following procedures for our agility trial at Crown Sports Center for the safety of our exhibitors and adherence to State and CDC requirements and guidelines.

We realize that this is a “no frills” trial and is different to what we are used to due to the COVID restrictions. However, the health and safety of everyone is paramount if we wish to continue holding agility trials. If during the trial you are unable to follow these procedures, we will ask you to leave and your entry fees will not be refunded. We want everyone to be safe!

GENERAL

- Please do not attend if you are sick or someone in your household is sick.
- Please practice social distancing at all times.
- There will be hand sanitizer stations throughout the building but bring your own for personal use. The club will not be providing gloves so please bring your own if desired.
- Parking is allowed again in the back along with the front.
- Crown will be cleaning periodically during the day and sanitizing our ring and crating ring every night. Crown will have their day care with children in another part of the building.
- The café may not be open and there will not be a food truck. Please bring your own food and drinks. Food cannot be eaten in the building on any of the fields. MACH/PACH parties will not be allowed **UNLESS** treats are **individually wrapped**.
- Water will be available for our volunteers.

TRIAL INFORMATION AND RULES

- **Volunteers.** If you would like to volunteer to work, please contact If you would like to volunteer to work, please contact Janis Mandrus, janisman@gmail.com (917) 929-4450, our volunteer coordinator, and she will be happy to find you a job!
- **Crating.** Please leave 6 feet of space between crates in the crating ring. Alternatively you can crate in your vehicles or there may be tents outside that you can crate under.
- **The gate will be electronic only.** We will be using agility gate.
- **Course maps** will be posted to the GoneDoggin’ Website. www.GoneDogginAgility.com, no later than 9 pm the previous evening. They will also be uploaded to Agility Gate. The course maps will also be posted on the wall outside the ring, but please do not congregate around them. Use your phone camera to take pictures of the maps if you haven’t downloaded the maps.
- **Trial results** will be posted in a binder on the check in table. **Ribbons** will be on a table for pickup when released.
- There will only be briefings for Novice, Open and games classes. No briefings for Ex/MAS, Premier or T2B classes. Our judge will be available for questions if needed.
- Masks are suggested for use during walk-throughs but not required.
- No spectator chairs in the ring. Please maintain social distancing on bleachers outside the ring.
- Only the next 5 dogs in the ring will be allowed in the ring area. All others please stay outside, in the crating area or on the bleachers. There will be markers on the floor to show the 5 staging areas.
- If you are taping a friends run, please only be in the ring to tape and then leave the ring area.
- As per AKC guidelines... “Exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, crossbody, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash the run will be scored as an “E”. If the leash falls out of the handler’s pocket, or off of their body, there is no call unless the dog grabs the leash”.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
